Required by Second Class Meeting

Camera – A Digital Single Lens Reflex (DSLR) camera is highly recommended. Most of these cameras have at least 6 megapixels. Canon & Nikon are the recommended brands.

Notebook, pen or pencil for note taking

Required by Week 2

Epson Ultra Premium Luster Paper (formerly known as Premium Luster Photo Paper) OR

Epson Ultra Premium Presentation Paper (formerly known as Enhanced Matte Paper)

The boxes will have 5 Stars on them if it is good paper

****DO NOT BUY ILFORD INK JET PAPER YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO USE IT****

An inexpensive portfolio (about 16 x 20) for turning in assignments and an additional folder

portfolio or box to hold unmatted prints

Beinfaang ColorMount - dry mount tissue for mounting your photographs

Kodak 18% Gray Card

(Don't buy this until you hear the lecture on mounting)

Matte Board for mounting work

White cotton gloves for handling finished work

Optional but HIGHLY recommended:

External Hard drive (Initialized as FAT32, it should work with a PC or a Mac)
